

The Swim

The Race

The start of the race is at 11.00am Saturday 13th February from Green Point Car Park and finishes at the Hampton Life Saving Club. Swimmers must wear the official timing device at all times during the race.

Distance: 1,200m

All competitors must register with Race Officials, collect swim cap and electronic timing device before 10.30am on race day.

The Course

The Course is accurately measured by GPS so it will be a full 1200 metre swim. To maximize competitor safety Hampton Life Saving Club personnel will be present in the water for the duration of the swim.

Competitors must complete course as marked and indicated in course briefing.

Minimum age for competitors is 12 years and the maximum is 80 years.

All competitors must be capable of completing the 1200m course in less than 50 minutes.

Agree to release and indemnify the organisers and sponsors of the Point to Point Swim Event ("the event") and their employees, representatives and members from all liabilities, claims, rights or causes of action which I or my heirs, executors, administrators or any other person may have in respect of my death and any damages, costs or expenses in any way connected with my participation in this event, including all injuries that may be suffered by me before, during or after the event. I understand this waiver includes all claims based on negligence, action or inaction of the organisers and/or sponsors of the event and/or their employees, representatives and/or agents.

Agree in the event of the race cancellation due to storms, rain, inclement sea or weather, winds or other "Acts of God" conditions, my entry fee will be non-refundable.

Attest I have trained for this event and verify that I am physically fit and have not been advised otherwise by a licensed medical practitioner. I am not aware of any medical condition that may affect my ability to safely participate in this event.

Consent to receive medical treatment which may be deemed advisable in the event of injury, accident and/or illness during the event or related activities.

Acknowledge that I have the sole responsibility for my personal possessions during the event and its related activities. The organisers or sponsors of the event and their servants shall have no liability for any loss or damage occurring to any personal effects placed in their custody.

Will permit the free use of my name and pictures in any form of media whatsoever pertaining to the event by the organisers and/or sponsors.

WARNING UNDER THE FAIR TRADING ACT 1999

Under the provisions of the **Fair Trading Act 1999** several conditions are implied into contracts for the supply of certain goods and services. These conditions mean that the supplier named on this form is required to ensure that the recreational services it supplies to you are-

Rendered with due care and skill; and

As fit for the purpose for which they are commonly bought as it is reasonable to expect in the circumstances; and

Reasonably fit for any particular purpose or might reasonably be expected to achieve any result you have made known to the supplier.

General Conditions of Entry:

Good sportsmanlike conduct and friendly competition is expected of all participants. Course officials have the authority to immediately disqualify any competitor exercising unsportsmanlike behaviour.

This event is not for the casual swimmer. It is the participant's responsibility to undertake a thorough physical and medical examination prior to competing.

In the interests of swimmer safety, organisers, at their discretion, reserve the right to postpone or cancel the event or alter the swim course.

Swim caps are compulsory and will be provided. Goggles and wet-suits are recommended.

Extraneous aids including, but not limited to fins, boards, snorkels, flotation devices, support teams, vehicles or escort paddlers are NOT permitted.

Swimmers must have their registered official race number clearly visible at finish.

Time limit for race is 50 minutes.

Swimmers shall be responsible for ensuring their electronic timing device is returned to representatives of Hampton Life Saving Club or Rotary Club of Sandringham. A \$50 fee will be charged for each transponder not returned.

Life Savers or Medical Staff have final authority to remove a swimmer from the race if they are judged to be incapable of continuing without risk of injury.

Decisions by the Race Director are final and not subject to appeal.

Please obey directions from Finish Line Officials and stay in order of finish until your race number is recorded.

Competitors will produce proof of age upon request.

The organisers collect personal information from this Entry Form to:

- ▶ Send you information and Entry Forms for the next Swim.
- ▶ Contact you in case of emergency
- ▶ Provide medical treatment to you if required.

You may access, update, correct or ask to have your personal information from our database removed by writing to the Rotary Club of Sandringham at the mailing address.

Under section 32N of the **Fair Trading Act 1999**, the supplier is entitled to ask you to agree that these conditions do not apply to you. If you sign this form, you will be agreeing that your rights to sue the supplier under the **Fair Trading Act 1999** if you are killed or injured because the services were not rendered with due care and skill or they were not reasonably fit for their purpose, are excluded, restricted or modified in the way set out in this form.

NOTE: The changes to your rights, as set out in this form, do not apply if your death or injury is due to gross negligence on the supplier's part. "Gross negligence" is defined in the Fair Trading (Recreational Services) Regulations 2004.
