**LIFE SAVING PATROLS**

Becoming a volunteer Life Saver involves learning the skills needed to offer first aid and to perform rescues using a board, tube or boat; but more importantly, you will learn teamwork. You do not have to participate in 'water activities' – you can specialise in advanced resuscitation, first aid or radio communication, all essential parts of the Life Saving Team. Once you are qualified, you are allocated to a patrol team, and you are rostered to patrol throughout the summer season. The season is from the end of November until Easter Monday, on Saturdays, Sundays and Public Holidays.

**JUNIOR TRAINING – SUMMER and WINTER**

Juniors / Nippers are divided into their respective age groups, requiring a minimum of two trainers per group. We team trainers up; so those with less life saving experience are placed with someone more experienced. This gives the trainers the opportunity to develop their skills whilst coaching the nippers.

**JUNIOR BEACH TRAINING**

Junior beach training, for children aged between 6 and 12 years, is held Saturday afternoon throughout the patrol season. There are plenty of fun activities arranged including basic life saving skills, aquatic safety, beach sprints and board paddling. (Registration commences at 3:15 pm – Training commences at 3:30 pm SHARP).

**WINTER POOL TRAINING – ALL AGES**

We offer training and testing for the Life Saving award scheme, which gives participants the necessary qualifications to compete. There are a number of indoor swimming pool carnivals conducted for all age groups over the winter period.

**COMPETITION**

Life Saving competition is open to all qualified members, and includes events such as swimming, ski and board paddling, beach sprints relays and flags. Competitions are held in age groups 7 to under 14 years; under 16; under 19; open and masters age groups. As a competitor you have the opportunity to compete at a club, state or national level.

**SOCIAL COMMITTEE**

Hampton Life Saving Club provides many social opportunities. Assistance in developing new ideas, more importantly assistance in running organised events is always sought

**BARBECUE**

A barbeque for members is held Saturday afternoon during the patrol season. Volunteers are needed to set up, cook and pack up.

**SPECIALIST SKILLS**

In an effort to keep costs to a minimum, members are often willing to offer their specialist skills that the club can call on if required (eg. Electrician/plumber).
